Arnold B. Sherman, currently living in Tyler, Texas, is a freelance composer, co-founder of Red River Music and Music and FineArts Director at Pollard First United Methodist Church in Tyler, Texas. His undergraduate work in Music Education was done at Montgomery College, Rockville, Maryland and Baylor University, Waco, Texas. Arnold is the founder and former director of the East Texas Handbell Ensemble, a community handbell choir located in the Tyler area. In frequent demand as clinician and guest conductor, he has led choral and handbell workshops, festivals and reading sessions throughout the United States, Canada, England, Japan and the Bahamas. Arnold has numerous choral and handbell pieces in print, and has been the recipient of an ASCAP Standard Award for each of the last eight years. An active member of Handbell Musicians of America, he has served as Area 9 Chair.
